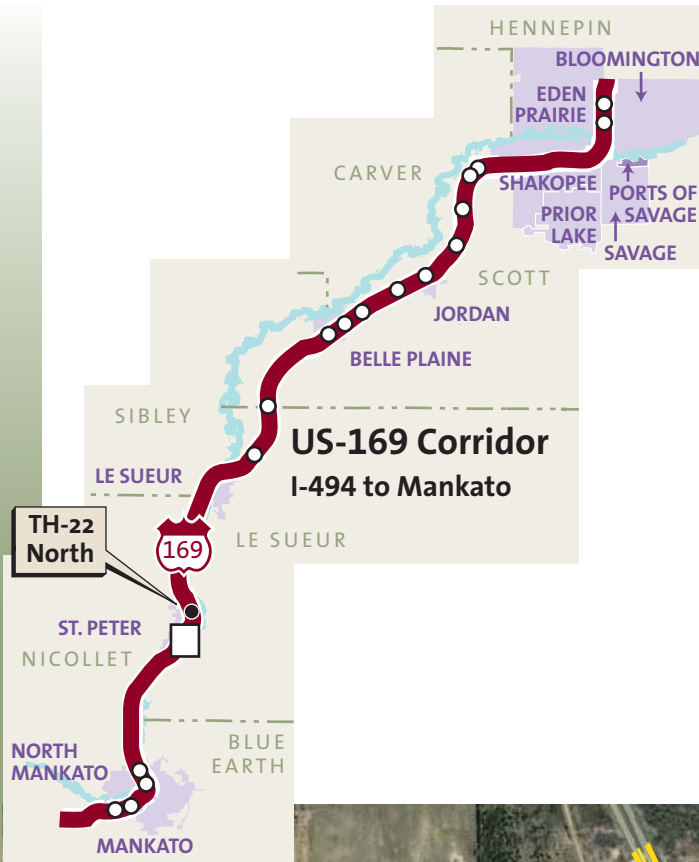




TH-22 NORTH INTERCHANGE IN ST. PETER

SAFE ACCESS AND IMPROVED TRAFFIC FLOW



As a transportation corridor, US-169 is important to the region. The population of the city is increasing – currently St. Peter’s population is up 10 percent from seven years ago. Alternative transportation access to US-169 is needed to accommodate the increase in traffic on the north end of the city. TH-22 also provides access to the city’s community hospital and industrial parks.

COMMUNITY BENEFITS

The proposed interchange will improve the area in the following ways:

- Provide better traffic flow and safer access for local businesses and individuals.
- Direct safe access from TH-22 to US-169.
- Serve the expanding growth area north of St. Peter.
- Eliminate the need for a stoplight on US-169.

FUNDING

The City of St. Peter is requesting federal and state assistance for the project based on the regional significance of the proposed TH-22 north interchange.

Estimated total project cost: \$11.2 million.
